Notes for Match Officials: -

Each referee is requested to confirm acceptance, or otherwise, of their appointment(s) to the SFA Referee Administration Department by e-mail. If, after having confirmed acceptance, it is necessary to withdraw from an appointment, contact should initially be made by telephone with the SFA Referee Administration Department and thereafter confirmed by e-mail.

Match Fees

Referee: £30

Assistants: £25 inclusive of expenses

Cup Competitions

All matches shall be played to a finish i.e. extra time and/or kicks from the penalty mark

Pitch Inspections/Postponements

If the ground is unplayable the Home Club must inform their opponents, the referee and the League Secretary not later than 10am on the day of the match, or by 2pm for an evening match, or as agreed by both Clubs. As far as possible, a referee should make the decision about a pitch being playable or unplayable. A Club may only declare a pitch unplayable the day before the fixture date in the event of extreme weather conditions or on the grounds of the health and safety of the players, officials or spectators of both Clubs. The League Secretary may appoint a referee to carry out a pitch inspection. The cost of such an inspection to be divided equally between the two Clubs.

Notes for Clubs: -

Home Clubs should contact the referee at least four days prior to the match to confirm arrangements i.e. venue and kick-off time.
