- To represent the Youth Congress at National events, Scottish FA and external events as and when required to do so.
- To be a spokesperson for the Youth Congress and be a positive role model at all times.
- Establish a good rapport with a Scottish FA representative and other football groups/members.
- Support a Scottish FA representative to develop their area of the business with children and young people in mind.
- Support other Youth Congress members to fulfil their duties.
- Coordinate Youth Congress projects.
- Deliver tasks on time and to a high standard.
- Be an ambassador for equality, diversity and inclusion and Children's Rights and Wellbeing across Scotland.
