COURSE OVERVIEW

The Scottish FA are delighted to introduce this brand new coaching award which will be for a small, hand-picked group who have aspirations to work at the elite level of the game. The course is designed to be highly technical in nature and will delve in depth into a number of key topics.

Whilst the course is not UEFA accredited, it is designed to compliment the existing coach education provision and provides an enhanced opportunity for young aspiring coaches who want to accelerate their development. Please note, candidates will achieve all required CPD hours via completion of the course.

FUNDING & ATTENDANCE

The course, which will be fully funded for the selected applicants, will feature 12 gatherings, once per month for two consecutive days. Full attendance outside of exceptional circumstances is mandatory and candidates are expected to complete coursework to a high standard between each gathering.

Candidates who do not feel they have the time to invest in this process or are not prepared to commit to ongoing coursework are advised not to apply.

In return for Scottish FA funding on this award, it is our intention that intellectual property developed through the course can be shared to develop insights and CPD for our game.



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS & INTERVIEW PROCESS

Places will be selected on the basis of the coach's demonstrated commitment, potential and ambition rather than qualifications or CV, but coaches should possess two of the following as a minimum requirement:

- Demonstrable Experience in the Game
- Degree in Sport-related subject
- UEFA B Licence

- UEFA B Youth Licence
- Advanced Children's Licence

For interview, coaches will be expected to prepare a presentation on their way of working via Zoom (circa 90 minutes), with suggested topics to include tactical ideas, approach to training methodology, use of multidisciplinary processes, and approach to managing players and staff.
