ROLE PURPOSE:

- Actively provide the opportunity for children and young people in Scotland to advise and support the direction of football in Scotland by consulting with the business and staff of the Scottish FA.
- Attend and contribute to the direction and action of the Youth Congress.
- Contribute to the embedding of diversity and inclusion across all of the activity of the Youth Ambassadors of Change and their sub committees.
- Recruit and chair a youth diversity and inclusion committee that will support both the Youth Congress and the work of the Diversity and Inclusion Manager.
- Contribute to other work involving children and young people and/or related projects as agreed by the Youth Congress.

KEY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend a minimum of 3 Youth Congress meetings per year.
- Agree, manage and complete a personal work plan with the Participation and Engagement Officer and Diversity and Inclusion Manager. You will also coordinate Youth Congress projects if and when required.
- Support other Youth Congress members to fulfil their duties.
- Represent the Youth Congress at National events, Scottish FA and external events as and when required to do so.
- To be a spokesperson for the Youth Congress and be a positive role model at all times.
- Recruit and Chair a youth diversity and inclusion committee, then, with the Participation and Engagement Officer, manage the agenda and work of this committee.
- Establish good rapport with Scottish FA representatives and other football groups/members as and when necessary.
- Abide by Scottish FA standards of professionalism.
- Be an ambassador for equality, diversity and inclusion, and Children's Rights and Wellbeing across Scotland.
