- Contribute to other work involving children and young people and/or related projects as agreed by the Youth Congress.
- Develop a project that actively contributes to the future strategic vision and success of the Scottish FA.

- Attend a minimum of 3 Youth Congress meetings per year.
- Agree, manage and complete a personal work plan with the Participation and Engagement Officer and your fellow Project Youth Ambassadors. You will also coordinate Youth Congress projects if and when required.
- Support other Youth Congress members to fulfil their duties.
- Represent the Youth Congress at National events, Scottish FA and external events as and when required to do so.
- Be a spokesperson for the Youth Congress and be a positive role model at all times.
- Working within a small subgroup made up of other Project Youth Ambassadors you will create and define a project within the scope of the Scottish FA's work.
- Research and develop your project against the future vision of the Scottish FA's 2020 vision, strategic paper.
- Deliver your project and potential recommendations to contribute to the positive future and growth of the Scottish FA and Scottish Football.
- Work toward the strategic goals and development of the Scottish FA and Scottish Football at large.
- Establish good rapport with Scottish FA representatives and other football groups/members as and when necessary.
- Abide by Scottish FA standards of professionalism.
- Be an ambassador for equality, diversity and inclusion, and Children's Rights and Wellbeing across Scotland.
